The Hometown Games concept is to increase competition opportunities at the community level and to create a variation of funding and volunteer support.

There are five consistent and simple elements of Hometown Games.

- √ Increase competition by offering affordable, quality one day event.
- √ Branding Hometown Games logo will be consistent across the Province.
- √ Will create equity and more competitive opportunities for grass-root athletes.

- √ Provide an opportunity for organizations to make a significant and positive contribution locally for a modest investment.
- √ Increase volunteerism by activating volunteers for a shorter period of time.

Sponsorship

- √ This will provide an opportunity for businesses or organizations to make a significant contribution locally and provincially for a fee of \$5,000.00.

Host

This will allow businesses or organizations to organize a competition in their hometown. The host will involve volunteers and create committees in their own communities.
