



Special Olympics Ontario Community Day on February 1, 2009.

- Volunteers – Special Olympics will need to secure 50-60 volunteers to work from 10am-2pm. Volunteers will be split into 2 groups, 50/50 ticket sales and gate collections. Once the gate collections people are finished they will help with 50/50 sales as well. All volunteers can watch the 4th quarter of the game from the Media Gondola and will receive pizza. All the gate volunteers (20 total) who will be collecting donation will need to have Special Olympics t-shirts and something to collect donation in.
- Money raised - Money collected at gates by the volunteers and from 50/50 that evening will benefit Special Olympics. The Raptors will cut a cheque for the combined amount from the Raptors Foundation for Kids
- Signage – the Raptors will be producing Gate 1 banners and pole wraps for Special Olympics, but will require any logos and pictures, verbiage, and/or web address needed to be put on it.
- PSA – The Raptors will also run a Public Service Announcement in the arena throughout the afternoon. This PSA from Special Olympics will need to be on BETA SP or a high quality DVD format.
- VIPs – The Raptors will have a pair of courtside tickets set aside for a VIP (President, Chairman, etc.) for the game. This person speak pre-game on Raptors TV as well to highlight the charity.
